Here's a hand where declarer had to be very careful about entries to his hand. Take a look.

BIDDING: North made a takeout double of the weak two bid but South could do no more than pass over East's raise. When North made another double showing a very big hand, South came to life and jumped to the diamond game.

PLAY: West led the king of spades and South counted four possible losers: 1 spade, 2 hearts, and 1 club. Declarer realized he needed the king of clubs in the West hand to make the contract. He won the ace of spades and followed with the ace of diamonds. West showed out causing South a moment of thought, but he continued with the jack of diamonds overtaking with the king in his hand. Next, he led a low club to dummy's jack. Unless East had ducked the king, things were looking up for declarer. He next led the ten of diamonds overtaking with the queen in his hand. Another club went to dummy's queen and the last trump was drawn. Declarer cashed the ace of clubs and was delighted to see the king drop. Now he led the deuce of diamonds to the six in his hand and played the good ten of clubs pitching the spade from dummy. He trumped his last spade in dummy for this eleventh trick.

It's true a very lucky 3NT contract would make with an over trick but South was pleased with his result.

Here's a hand where I was lazy on defense and paid the price. Take a look.

BIDDING: South had a nice hand but his jump to game was an overbid. A game try would have done justice to his hand and North would have accepted.

PLAY: I was sitting East and my partner led my suit. After winning the first three diamonds I failed to give the hand enough thought and exited with a trump. Declarer had no trouble pulling trumps and quickly claimed ten tricks. My thought process should have been "South's jump to game marks him with most if not all of the missing honors. Therefore, my only hope of defeating the contract is a fourth round of diamonds in an attempt to promote the jack (or less likely the queen) of hearts". As you can see declarer could no longer make the hand. Down one would have been a tie for top.

Defense can be difficult but it's easier if you put in the effort.

#3

It is often wrong to ruff early when you are long in declarer's trump suit. In this hand, a defender couldn't wait use his trumps and that was the end of the defense.

BIDDING: Holding a very good hand, North made a takeout double of West's opening bid. With little to brag about, South made a minimum response in his spade suit. After West rebid his six-card suit, North cue bid hearts to show his extra strength. This suggested a holding of at most three spades for with more North would raise the suit. South now decided his hand was worth a jump to game and promptly did so.

PLAY: West led the top two hearts and saw his partner discard a club on the second round. West followed with a third round ruffed in dummy with the ten. East couldn't wait to over ruff with the king and that was the end of the defense. Declarer won the trump continuation with the ace, unblocked the jack of spades, and played three top clubs. East ruffed the third one with his last trump but declarer over ruffed and was able to discard his losing diamond and losing heart on dummy's good clubs.

If East discards another club instead of over trumping dummy at trick three, he will later score a second trump and defeat the contract.

#4

While there is no doubt overtricks are important in a pairs event, making the contract is usually your main priority. Take a look at this hand where the declarer had to be very careful.

BIDDING: North-South had an easy auction to 3NT.

PLAY: West led the five of spades and was pleased to see his partner play the queen. Before playing, declarer stopped to count his tricks. He had six tricks in the majors and it looked like it would be easy to establish three more in the minors. However, if the clubs didn't break 3-2 he would have to knock out two aces and the defenders might be able to establish their spade suit. Recognizing the importance of the ten of spades, he saw the solution. After winning the first trick, he led a heart to dummy. Next he led a low club and the defense was dead. If East rose with the ace, declarer would have four club tricks. If the club ace was in the West hand, spades could not be continued into declarer's K10. At the table, East ducked and after the club jack won the trick, declarer now switched his attack to diamonds for two more tricks. If he had instead continued clubs, he would have been defeated by the 4-1 break.

Note that if declarer had played a high club from dummy, he was not going to succeed.

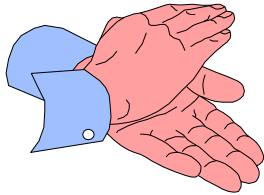
